

## **CONTRACT FOR EMERGENCY SERVICES FOR THE YEAR 2014/2015**

**THIS AGREEMENT** is made and entered into this 7<sup>th</sup> day of OCT 2013 by and between the Town of Yacolt, Washington and North County Community Food Bank, a registered nonprofit corporation ("NCCFB").

### **WITNESSETH:**

**WHEREAS**, the NCCFB operates as a nonprofit social service agency within North Clark County providing emergency services to low income households throughout the Town of Yacolt, City of Battle Ground, and North Clark County; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the Town of Yacolt deems vital an agency in the North County area continues to be available to provide social services for dissemination of food to those people in crisis situations. NCCFB staff shall also provide referrals to other Clark County social service agencies offering assistance with electric, gas and water utilities, medical, housing, family and teen counseling, domestic violence, anger/conflict management, depression and suicide prevention, as well as other food banks.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties agree as follows:

**Section 1, Services.** The North County Community Food Bank ("NCCFB") shall provide certain social services to the citizens of the Town of Yacolt, City of Battle Ground, and North Clark County as needed. Said services shall include dissemination of emergency food products to those in need; the coordination of crisis intervention, referrals for assistance with utilities and water bills, medical, housing, domestic violence, anger/conflict management, depression and suicide prevention, as well as other area food banks. The NCCFB will serve as the North Clark County agency in the distribution of USDA Commodities distribution the first three weeks of each month as well.

**Section 2, Location.** NCCFB will continue to operate the facility out of their facilities within the City of Battle Ground and provide sufficient personnel or volunteers to adequately perform the services required.

**Section 3, Compensation.** The Town of Yacolt shall pay to NCCFB for calendar year 2014 the sum of \$ 2,000.00. This sum may be paid quarterly.

Section 4. Termination. This contract shall terminate at the end of each calendar year, unless renewed by the Town of Yacolt through its annual budget process.


