There was a discussion on the Red Fir's application to the State Gambling Commission to obtain a public card room Class D license. A workshop on the matter was scheduled for 7:30 p.m. on Monday, May 14, 2007.



Mayor Warren reminded the Council that spring clean up will be held on Saturday, April 14th.


