## C. Work session Zoning Ordinance #371 Update with Gary Albrecht, Clark County Planning

Gary Albrecht, Clark County Planning is working on the update to zoning ordinance # 371 and brought to the meeting information regarding the deletion of zoning of heavy manufacturing. There was discussions on making all light manufacturing zones conditional use if it was conditional use in heavy manufacturing. Pete Roberts, Public Works Director, asked that all light manufacturing be conditional use where it was not permitted before so that there didn't have to be another update when that issue came around. There was discussion with David Ridenour, town attorney about the creation of a draft ordinance and formatting for the next meeting and general discussions on hazardous types not being permitted where not permitted in heavy manufacturing. The town received a grant from to replace the street lights with LED lights. There will be a few changes to the lamps. The State opened up funding under the TIB grant and the town was able to get funding for several areas in town including the RR Ave & Hoag St crossings which have been a huge problem. Other areas will be patch work on Parcel, work on Johnson St & Ranck. Rotschy will be smoothing out the soccer field for \$50.00 for the town.
