

ORDINANCE NO. 214B

AN ORDINANCE establishing and adopting the WATER RATES for the Town of Yacolt, Yacolt, Washington.

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Yacolt, Washington, is in special session, this second day of OCTOBER, 1980; and

WHEREAS, all members of the Town Council are in agreement that the Water Rates for the Town of Yacolt's Water Department do not meet the operational and maintenance costs of said system; and

WHEREAS, said members of the Town Council do hereby declare and agree that a raise in said rates are in need at this point in time, and that this ordinance shall provide for increases in rates as need for the future' and

WHEREAS, all members of the Town Council have had full notice of the time, place and purpose of the meeting of said council.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF YACOLT, WASHINGTON, as follows:

Section I.

Rate for 3/4" to 1" meters. The rate and scale for 3/4" to 1" meters shall be as follows:

- A. For first 500 cubic feet,
or flat rate..... \$12.00 minimum charge
- B. Next 500 cubic feet..... \$ 1.00 per 100 cu.ft.
- C. Next 400 cubic feet..... \$ 1.25 per 100 cu ft.
- D. Next 1,000 cubic feet..... \$ 1.50 per 100 cu.ft.
- E. Over -----cubic feet..... \$ 0.30 per 100 cu.ft.

Section II

Rate for 1 1/2" to 2" meters. The rate and scale for 1 1/2" to 2" meters shall be as follows:

- A. For the first 500 feet,
or flat rate \$18.00 minimum charge
- B. Next 500 cubic feet..... \$ 1.50 per 100 cu.ft.
- C. Next 500 cubic feet..... \$ 1.00 per 100 cu.ft.

- D. Next 1,000 cubic feet..... \$ 0.50 per 100 cu.ft.
 - E. Over _____ cubic feet..... \$.0.25 per 100 cu.ft.
- Resident's meters can be handled by contract.

Section III

Surcharge. There will be a ten percent (10%) surcharge required to all water rate services outside the town limits of Yacolt, Washington. New meter connection charges will be assigned under Ordinance No. 206.

Water Rates by Contract. Water rates for larger meters beyond as set forth herein shall be handled by individual contract.

HydrantMeters. A \$150.00 deposit shall be placed at the Town Hall as security with the rate being \$1.00 per 100 cubic feet or by special contract and otherwise required by the Public Works Department.

Commercial accounts may be handled on contract by special request.

The remaining terms and conditions of said Ordinance No. 206 and this ordinance No. 214B shall remain in full force and effect.

DULY ADOPTED THIS 2nd DAY OF October, 1980, to become effective as of 1 October, 1980.
